General Information:

- ___ Student will follow all safety rules in the lab, shop, and practice field.
- ___ Students will be expected to attend meetings throughout the season.
- ___ Students must be respectful and follow captain, mentor and chaperone directions and instructions.
- ___ Students are encouraged, but not required, to be present at all team competitions and outreach events.
- ___ All students must display gracious professionalism during build season, competitions, and outreach events.
- ___ No drinking, smoking, or use of unapproved non-prescription drugs will be allowed at any time.
- ___ During events, including transporting to/from the event, students will be required to follow all rules and guidelines of FIRST, Team 3130, and the code of conduct.
- ___ Students must take full responsibility for all personal belongings at all times.

Competitions and Travel:

- ___ Competitions require travel. Families are responsible for travel plans, including transportation, hotel costs and food. Blocks of rooms, arranged through the team, will be available for reservation. Information will be provided.
- ___ Parents are responsible for their child during off-site events. If a parent cannot attend they are responsible for making arrangements with another parent or mentor. A travel form must be signed by the legal guardian of all students traveling without family.
- ___ Students may not enter the rooms assigned to members of the opposite sex or the rooms of people other than the Fighting Calculators or the Errors members at any time without a parent or adult chaperone present.
- ___ Students are to keep their parent or chaperones informed of where they will be at all times.

Students will not leave the hotel for any reason unless given permission from their parent or chaperone.

Consequences:

Violation of team rules or any other illegal activities may result in immediate extraction from the group, parental contact, early cancellation of a trip, dismissal from the team, and/or local law enforcement contact. Any future trips will also be forfeited at the expense of the student & their family.

All school rules will be in effect throughout the season. School disciplinary action WILL be enforced upon the return to school from a trip.

Permission to attend does not guarantee attendance at any or all events.

I hereby understand the rules and expectations stated above. I will adhere to any consequences and financial responsibility for the actions taken.
